How to Keep the Blessings of God

This summer started out with bearable temperatures and cooling rain showers. In June, during Vacation Bible School, the weather started heating up and drying out. Then hot August hit us in the middle of July with heat indexes reaching 107 degrees!

Naturally, GPBC's very first Sports Camp was conducted during those sun-filled and very humid evenings. Even though we were hot and sticky feeling; we worked together as the Body of Christ praising our Lord for His great blessings!

Now that we are coming to the end of summer vacation, the air will be changing to fall and school will soon be underway. I encourage everyone to join me in praying for God's blessings upon the new school year...and upon our church family. I want to share some thoughts I learned from Rick Warren on how to keep the blessings of God...

1. **Purity**—If God is going to bless us continually—year after year—we have to be consistent in the little things. We cannot take for granted our quiet time, our moral integrity, or our personal relationships. It's easy to be so focused on other people that we completely take for granted our own personal purity.

Moses was ready to lead the Israelites out of captivity, but he also had to remain pure in keeping his own family spiritually focused upon God. This teaches us that God will not excuse us for impurity in our personal lives. Whatever setting we find ourselves, stay true (pure) to the teachings of God's Word.

2. **Maturity**—God blesses us in ministry when we keep growing and we grow by being pruned. God will prune us in order for us to grow richer, fuller, and mature for His kingdom's work. We mature through studying God's Holy Book, the Bible. We also grow by coming to GPBC's times of Bible study and worship. God's way to maturity is through pruning us by means of studying the righteous life of Christ.

Jesus tells us in **John 15** that the only way to be fruitful is through pruning. When we prune plants in our garden, we are not cutting off the dead wood; we are cutting away parts that are alive. For our ministry to keep the blessings of God, He may require us to prune some very good things from our life and from our ministry. Remember...pruning causes thicker more vibrant growth!
