

Older Kids Bible-Learning Activity: MAKE A BOOKS OF THE BIBLE BOOKMARK

Memorizing the books of the Bible can be challenging. Use this activity to help kids memorize the order of books in God's Word, easily locate particular books during study time, and mark their place in Scripture.

Supplies needed:

- Colored construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Crayons
- Ribbon
- Holepunch

Instructions:

1. Make a copy of the provided bookmarks for each child in the class.
2. Provide crayons for kids to color the borders and inside of the bookmarks.
3. Instruct kids to cut out each of the bookmarks.
4. Kids will then cut a piece of construction paper slightly larger than the provided bookmark pieces.
5. Provide glue for kids to stick the printed bookmark sides onto each side of the construction paper.
6. Let kids take turns using the hole punch to punch a hole in the top of the bookmark.
7. Instruct kids to tie a ribbon through the hole. Now their bookmarks are complete!

Option:

Use scalloped scissors to give the bookmark a funky edge.
