### "St. Patrick's Day Trivia"

During the month of March, we celebrate St. Patrick's Day.

Who is St. Patrick anyway? Saint Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland. He was a Christian missionary given credit with converting Ireland to Christianity in the AD 400's. Legend has it that St.

Patrick would use the shamrock to explain the Trinity- Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The word "shamrock" comes from the Gaelic word "seamrog" (In Irish, it means "summer plant") meaning "trefoil" (three leafed) or "little clover". The shamrock is the national flower of Ireland. We celebrate St. Patrick's Day on March 17<sup>th</sup> because it is said to be the date of his death.

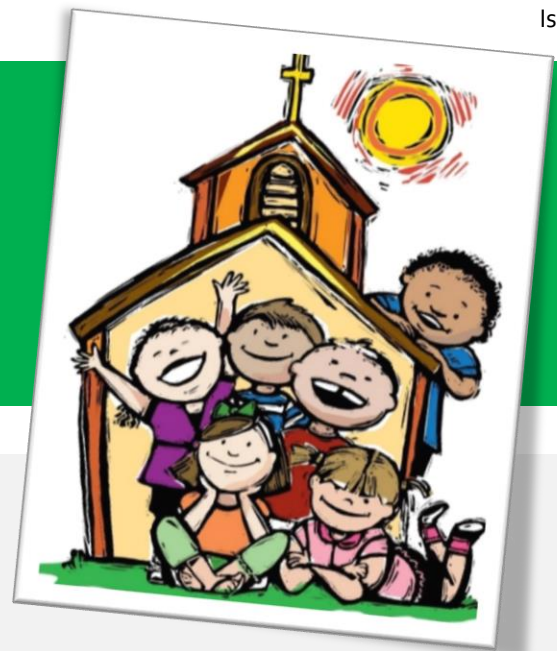

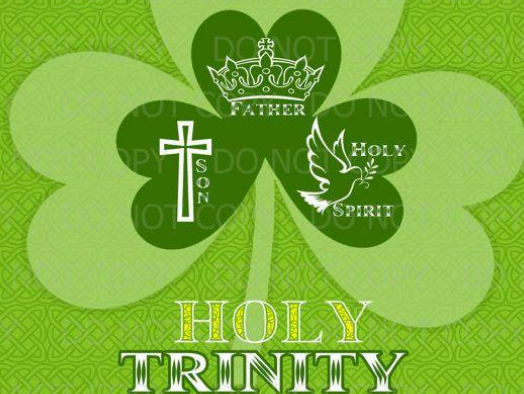
