John 14:26

26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name will teach you all things, and will remind you of everything I have said to you. 27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

We can all use a little encouragement.

Father, I thank you for those reminders. I thank you for our Pastor, continue to anoint him with your word. I thank you for the deacons of our church, give them all your wisdom and guidance in decisions that have to be made. I thank you for all my brother's and sister's in Christ, help us all to support and encourage one another, help us all to remain in your peace. Amen
