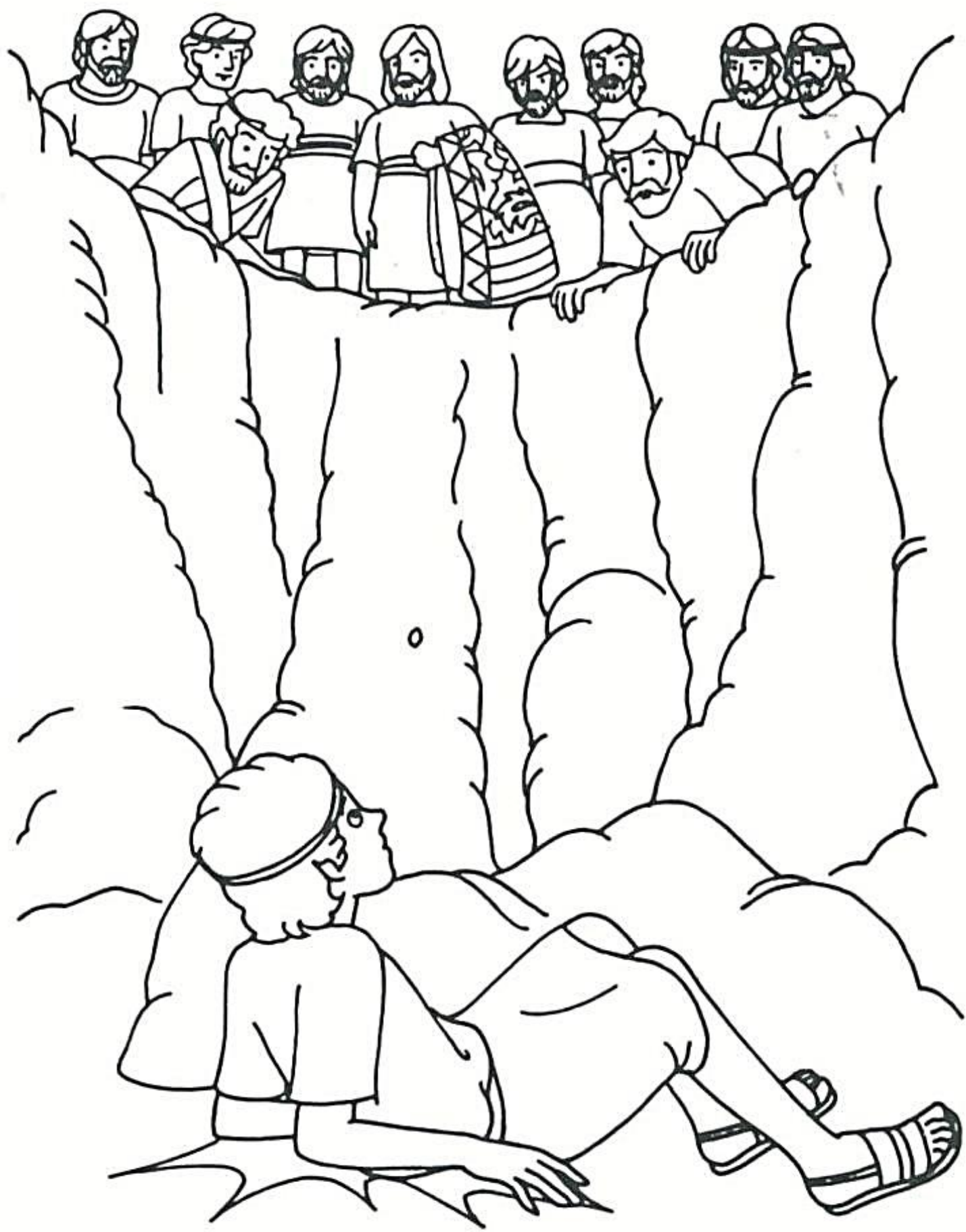

Coloring Page: Joseph’s Coat of many Colors- Color by Number

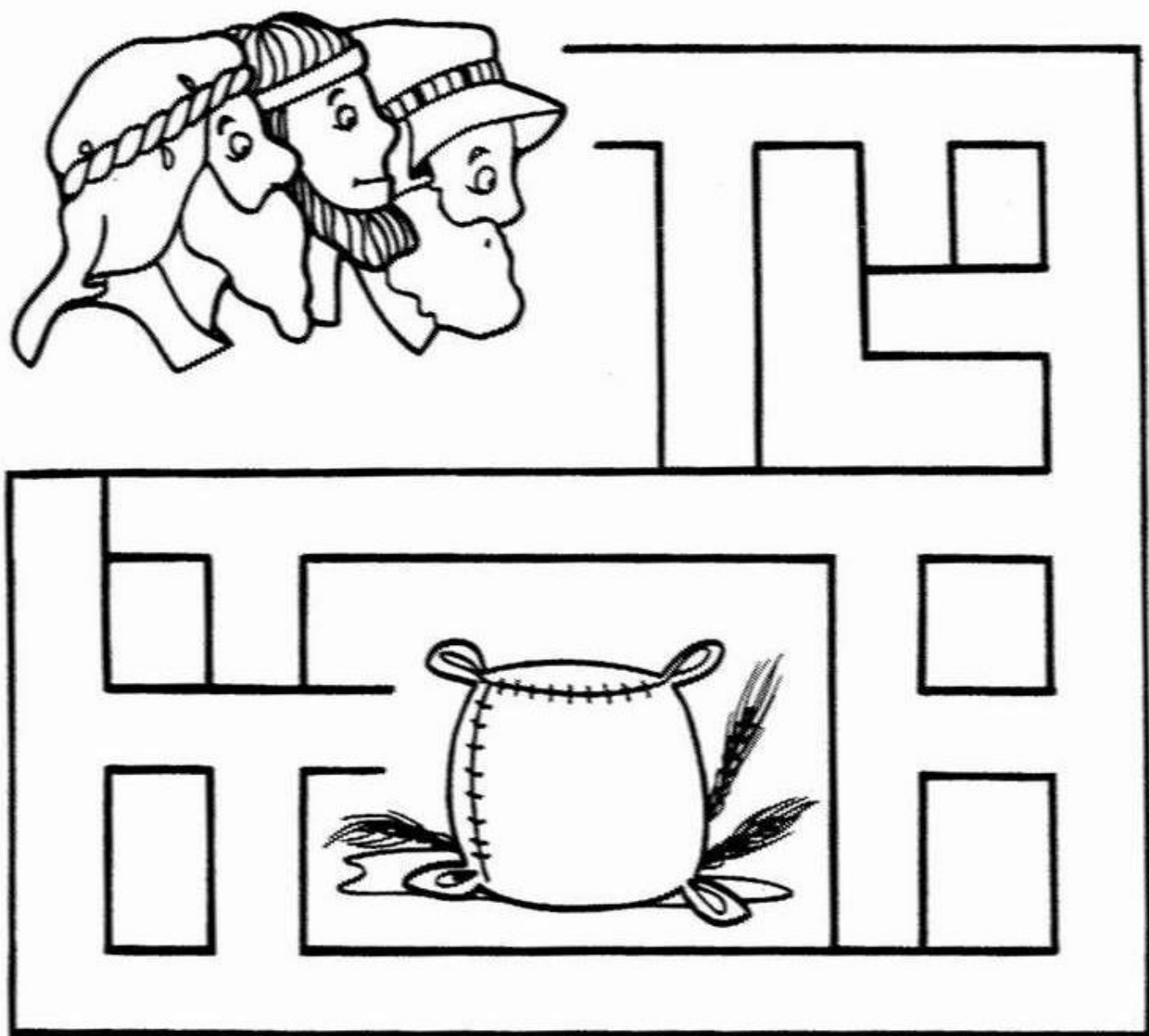
Coloring Page: Joseph thrown in the well

Snack: Joseph's Coat of Many Colors

Supplies: graham crackers, frosting, fruit strips, plastic knife, paper plate

Place the graham cracker on the paper plate. Cut two smaller rectangles from another graham cracker for sleeves. Put these on either side of the larger rectangle making a coat shape. Frost the coat. Use the fruit strips to make an ornamental coat like Jacob gave Joseph.
