**Bible Story:**

- Today’s story is about a man named Naaman. Naaman was very sick and did not know God. His servant girl had a relationship with God and knew that he could heal Naaman. God sent a helper named Elisha to help Naaman. God sends us helpers when we are sick or in need. Who are the helpers that God sends to us? How can we be helpers when others are in need? Our story today comes from the book of 2 Kings, it is in the Old Testament. Ask them to show which section of the bible is the Old Testament and which section is the New Testament.

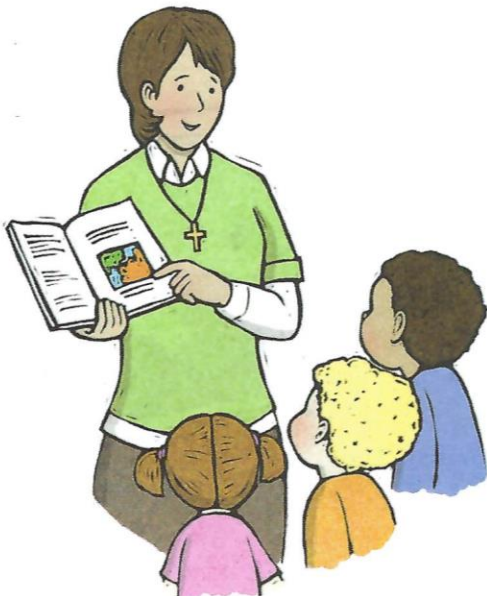
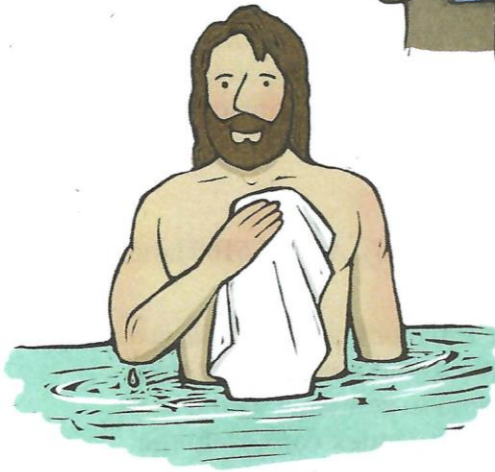
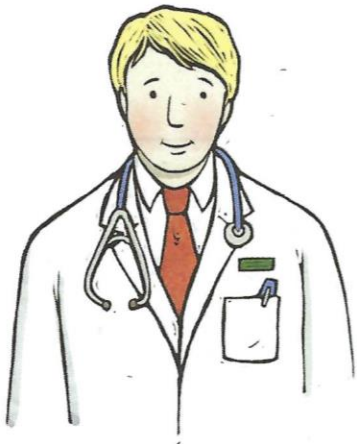

# God Sends Helpers!

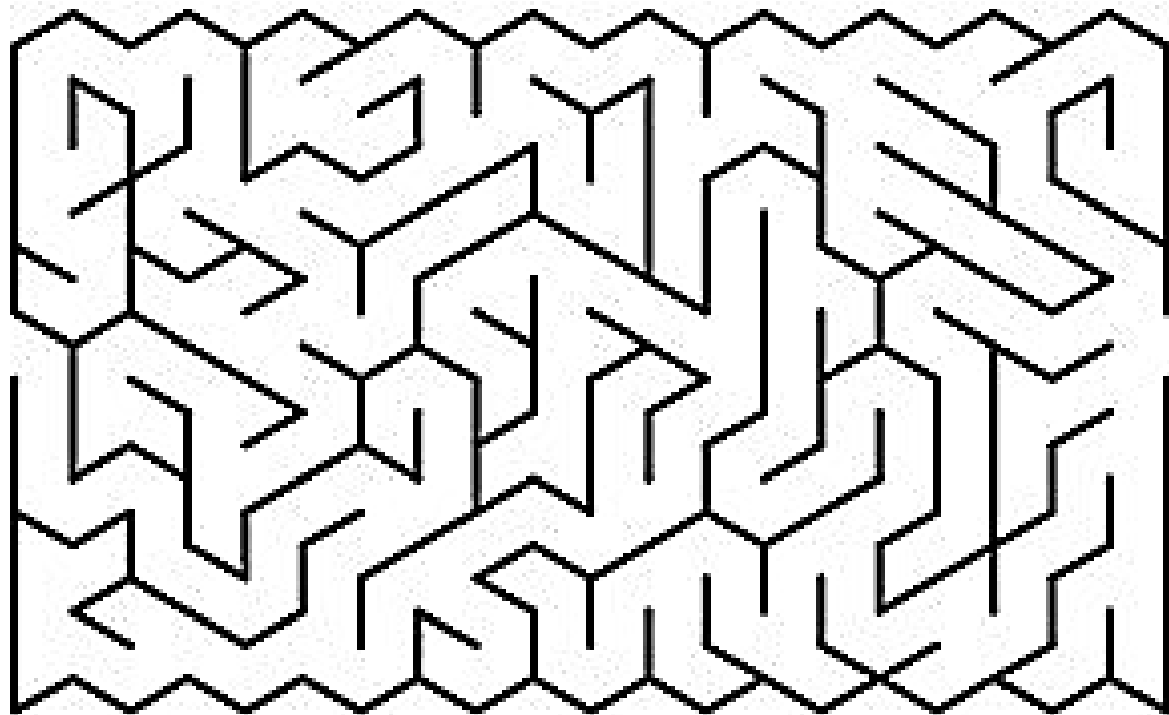
Look at the picture of Naaman bathing in the Jordan River. Name and circle the present day helpers God gives us to help family members when they are sick.
