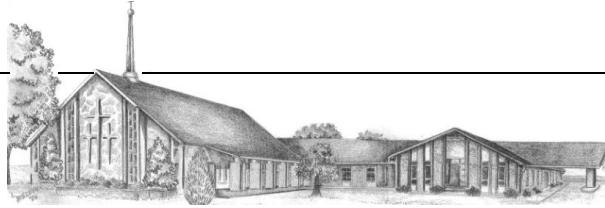

## Announcements

- 2) **Budget requests** are due by next **Sunday, October 4, 2020**. Your committee and ministry request should be placed in the Budget and Finance Committee’s mailbox, in the Church office.
- 3) GPBC, along with other area churches, is collecting **nonperishable** food items and hygiene items, along with **nonperishable** baby food and baby hygiene items. Your donations can be brought to our church during office hours, M-F 9am-12pm, and dropped in the box outside the Narthex entrance. They will be taken to Bellamy where county residents can go for the monthly distribution.

- 5) The **Children’s Ministry** is meeting on **Wednesday** nights from **6pm-7pm** outside at GPBC. This past Wednesday we had 12 children and 6 adult workers.
