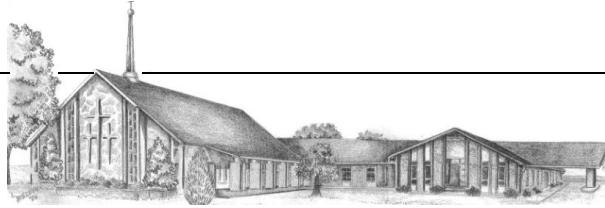

- 3) The Personnel Committee is seeking a regularly attending church member to fill the **Children & Youth Coordinator** position that will be vacant effective November 30, 2020.
