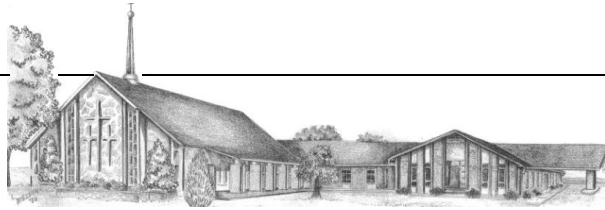

This is a 10 hour a week position with no leave benefits. Starting Salary is \$12,000.00.

This action would need to be presented to the church body for approval prior to any further advertisement.
