"Overcomer" Lap 2 Let's review September's Vision Article: Alex and Stephen Kendrick's movie, "Overcomer" is a God inspired movie teaching us that we can overcome the world!

"Overcomer" is based upon a true story about a Christian school that loses their basketball program. God uses the track team to help the school grow deeper in their faith.

Hannah, the school track star, learned faith lessons through reading (Ephesians 1 and 2). From Lap 1, Hannah's faith taught her:

> One runner matters, so step up!
> Running is terrible, why would anyone want to do this? Endurance helps us push through our difficulties. This is what we've got, make the best of it, live to God's Glory!
> Love, pray, be present for people, forgive, don't give up!
> One person is a team – one makes a difference.
> Who are you - a basketball coach, a history teacher a husband a wife take

history teacher, a husband, a wife, take it all away – who are you? How important is being a Christian? 6. Our identity is tied to what our heart is tied to! (This is the movies main focus)

7. What is 1st place in your life? Your identity is in the One who created you, God!

8. When it all turns against you, where do you turn, turn to God! Pray for His Guidance.

9. Who are you? God loves you!

10. It is easy to blame: others, the president, and even God for your mistakes! Ask God to forgive you of your mistakes. Say I'm sorry, be honest, be honest with God because He loves you.
11. God allows us to be broken to get our attention – He wants our heart!

"Overcomer" concludes this way: Hannah is continuing to grow in her faith. Here are more faith lessons she is learning:

> 1. It's hard to FORGIVE! 2. Our Heavenly Father Forgives us and loves us. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died to prove God's love for us. 3. We were created to know God. 4. Believing by faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord is the way for us to come to know God. **5.** Trust God through Christ to clean us up. Pray this prayer: "Lord Jesus, I am a sinner and I need saving. Lord Jesus, You are my Savior who Forgives me, come live in me." This Prayer will make us Brand New! 6. (Eph. 1 and 2) teach us that believers in Christ are blessed, chosen, forgiven, sealed, loved, saved, and God's child! 7. Who are vou? Hannah learned her identity is in Christ! 8. We are created by God; we are not a mistake!



What about Vision?

Vision is a physiological process where light is focused on the retina of the eye which sends electrochemical signals to the brain. These signals are interpreted by the brain giving us awareness of our surroundings and establishing memories associated with what we "see". The human body is quite miraculous in its function with vision being only one of the many interacting systems that make us what we are. A recent scare involving vision symptoms and a preliminary diagnosis of a torn retina while 7 hours away from my doctors, and the ensuing rush that followed, reminded me that I am not invincible. I knew that already, even though I don't tend to live as if I do. While I didn't need surgery, the situation is still resolving, compelling me to ponder clarity of vision and visionaries. The Bible contains many examples of individuals with clarity of vision and purpose. Nehemiah comes to mind as he rallied a discouraged and beaten people to come together with him to rebuild the temple in Jerusalem. He was able to inspire them to rise above their defeat with what God had laid upon his heart.

But all charismatic leaders are not furthering God's work. Adolf Hitler was able to manipulate people with his keen ability to draw in the crowd using words and gestures. People were in need and he took aim at their discontent with what appeared to be solutions. Clarity of vision also requires fine discrimination; the ability to discern differences and details that explain what is in our sights.

As Christians, particularly in this time of upheaval and seemingly unending drama, we need to carefully evaluate what is in our sight. Christian discernment, with our Lord as our guide, helps to insure we do not depart from Him and that we follow the wise path. I pray for keen perception to remain true to God and the work He would have me do. When the world seems to blur, I pray for clarity of vision and the ability to discern the truth. God is still in control: that I do not doubt and, though I cannot see the future, I pray for Him to be revealed and shine a light in the darkness to follow so we can follow and serve Him.
