During the month of February, our attention often turns to Valentine's Day. When we think of Valentines' Day, our hearts give a little extra attention to love. Love is described with tender words and heartfelt actions. As deeply as we love our family and friends, can we imagine how much deeper our Heavenly Father loves His family of believers. One of the finest expressions of God's profound love is recorded in (I Corinthians 13:8).

(*I Corinthians 13:8*), affirms God's love with these words, "Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away."

The Greek word for love used in this passage is the word "Agape." Agape is utilized to describe the everlasting, unconditional love of God. Chapter 13 is so well known that it is often quoted in the Scripture reading for weddings to emphasize the supremacy of love.

I encourage us to read the entire chapter of (I Corinthians 13) as often as possible to remind ourselves of the priority of love in God's heart. The Apostle Paul wrote that love is the greatest attribute of God that all

This verse applies to us this way: we can have faith to move mountains, give all our possessions to the poor, understand all mysteries and have all knowledge, and even die a martyr's death, BUT IF we do not have love, it means nothing. Love motivates us to take action. Love motivated Jesus Christ to leave Heaven and come to earth to save us from our sins!

The Bible continues teaching us regarding God's love. (I John 4:16) simply says that God is love. The very nature of God's being is an unconditional, everlasting love that never stops flowing to us. God's love will never fail us. Ever!

On February 14th (Valentine's Day) when many people celebrate love, may we all be mindful of the greatest love that comes from the Father to us through His Son, Jesus Christ. The love that God has for us will never fail! Earthly loves may disappoint us from time to time, but the love that God has for us will never change and will last forever!
