FOLLOW-UP REPORT FROM 4TH QUARTER BUSINESS MEETING

- The proposed changes to the Constitution & Bylaws were approved with the exception of two topics which did not have the required support by 2/3s of the voting members in attendance. Under Section 3. Deacons, the proposed language limiting active family members serving together and under Section 6. Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer, the proposed language requiring itemized expense reports for expenditures over \$500, were not approved and revert to the previously ratified wording.
- 2. The request to transfer \$10,000 from unused 2022 General Fund giving to the Van Replacement Fund was approved.
- 3. The request by the Pastor Search Team for an additional \$2800 in funds to be used for travel and lodging of prospective pastoral candidates was approved.
