I will ask each current committee to designate at least one person to be a part of this, for once we have the vision, we will need to incorporate it into all that we do. I know some of this can sound scary; we often think of change as something that makes us uneasy, but this should be exciting, a new chapter in the life of our church. I ask that you not be afraid; remember you have been filled with the Holy Spirit, have received His power, to be His witnesses. Would you join me in praying for our future?
